



Tequila originated in the town of Santiago de Tequila in the year 1600. The town was founded by Franciscan monks on the 15th of April, 1530. Tequila comes from the agave plant, also called ‘maguey’, agave is derived from the Greek word meaning noble. Agave is often mistaken for a cactus, but actually belongs to the lily family. The agave that makes tequila must come from either Jalisco, Guanajato, Michoacan, Reynosa, or Tampaulipas as designated by the Mexican government. There are 136 types of agave, but only the Blue Weber Agave is allowed in tequila production. The other 135 types of agave produce an ancient harsh spirit called mezcal, which is made of mostly sugar cane.

There are many myths about tequila. First being the worm. The worm was introduced in the 1940s as a marketing gimmick to boost mezcal sales. Second, that all tequilas are just bottled homebrew, Mexican moonshine. In truth the Mexican government has very strict regulations for all tequila houses. The last and most important myth is that the more expensive tequilas are better. Most tequila is, in fact, produced for the local market.

The Margarita

This is the concoction that fueled our taste for tequila in the 1960s. Before the margarita, tequila was known mainly in Central and South America. Tax records from the town of tequila note that 3 barrels of “mezcal wine” had been shipped to Texas in 1873, and American troops in pursuit of Pancho Villa had brought some back in 1916. Still, folks north of the border had not quite taken to the taste of tequila. Even when there was a shortage of gin during World War II, America’s interest in tequila proved to be nothing more than a flirtation. Then Californian college students discovered the Margarita, and the rest is history. As for the creation of the drink itself, several bars and bartenders have staked a claim.

The Caliente Racetrack in Tijuana boasts of its origin around 1930, as does Bertita's bar in Tasca, Mexico. And not to be denied a piece of the legend is an LA restaurant called The Tale of the Cock, where they claim to have created this recipe first during the Eisenhower Administration.

Later claims have been insisted upon not only by the Garci Crespo Hotel in Puebla, Mexico, around 1936 where the bartender says he named the drink for his girlfriend. Her name, of course, was Margarita. A couple from San Antonio, Texas also staked a claim to the margarita. They spent many an hour wasting away during the 1950's at the bar of the Flamingo Hotel in Acapulco, where they owned a home.

Finally the most documented claim comes from Danny Herrera the owner of Rancho La Gloria, located between Rosarito Beach and Tijuana. In the late 1940's, a showgirl named Marjorie King stopped there often, and she had a drinking "problem" of sorts, she was allergic to every form of booze except tequila, which she needed mixed. Among the many tequila experiments that Danny Herrera tried was a concoction consisting of 3 parts white tequila, 2 parts Cointreau, and 1 part fresh lemon juice. These he shook together in a container of shaved ice, then served up in a short stemmed glass rimmed with lemon juice and salt. This she liked, and so he gave the drink the Spanish name for Marjorie: *Margarita*.

That takes us to today.....

We travel to Jalisco a couple of times a year to taste, study and soak in the rich tradition of Tequila. Inspired by Julio Bermejo of Tommy's in San Francisco who travels there regularly we now make margaritas that showcase the character of 100% agave Tequila. We use 2 ounces of 100% Blue Agave Tequila, premium organic agave nectar, and fresh-squeezed lime juice. Julio has been making margaritas like this for years! We hope you enjoy this clean, bright and vibrant style of margarita. We also encourage you to visit Julio at Tommy's on Geary. He is a true Tequila Master and the originator of this ultimate margarita recipe!

TEQUILA BLANCO

Blanco Tequila, also referred to as silver or platinum, is arguably the purest expression of agave. Bottled no more than 60 days after distillation, although most are bottled immediately upon completing the distillation process.

I have splurged and made myself a handcrafted margarita with all of the tequilas listed below. Well worth the splurge and damn good!!

Each single barrel is precious and unique. It is then transferred to hand made black porcelain bottles that are hand painted, numbered and signed by the maker. The single barrel program launched in 2009. Rich, velvet and on the finish with aromas of rose petals and cedar.
